Keep this page for your referral on your responsibilities! THE RULES...

- 1) **MUST** have sign-up sheet with payment turned in before points will count (postmark determines date of sign up). **NO POINTS ARE RETROACTIVE!!!**
- 2) Must be a paid and current member of INPHC prior to points accumulating.
- 3) Must help at the horse show (contact show manager for assignment). Exceptions can be made if you help at an approved club event.
- 4) Must attend at least two (2) club meetings per year. Exceptions with prior board approval **ONLY**.
- 5) Must show to at least four (4) judges to qualify. Points will accrue on the horse for the open divisions and on the rider for youth, novice, and amateur divisions.
- 6) Futurities will count on the PAC program (must be reported and showing on the PAC printout).
- 7) Exhibitor will be responsible for tracking & separating equitation classes for PAC.
- 8) **POINTS:** will be accumulated based on the chart below (based on participation). Exhibitor must provide a print-out from APHA or a print-out from each show secretary to verify placings. Grand Champion Halter will receive 2 more points than their class placing and Reserve will receive 1 more point. In addition to your APHA print out, the attached point sheet can be used to supplement and make the points calculation easier on the points keeper.
